### **Development Cooperation Germany – Kenya**

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#### **Constitutional Reform**

- Constitutional Referendum 2010
- The new Constitution is a historical milestone in addressing the country`s long term challenges
- It will help to unlock further necessary reforms
- Germany is committed:
  - → To support Kenya in the implementation of their new Constitution, the reform agenda and fighting impunity and corruption





## Five guiding Principles for Kenyan- German future Development Cooperation

- Support inclusive Economic Growth and strengthen the Role of the Private Sector and Non-State Actors
- 2. Reduce Inequalities and Social Exclusion
- 3. Respect, Protect and Fulfil Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms
- 4. Support Political and Economic **Governance**, strengthening Accountability, Integrity, Transparency and the Rule of Law
- 5. Improve Aid Effectivness to achieve Development Result





#### **Guiding Principles**

- 1. Support Economic Growth and strengthen the Role of the Private Sector and Non-State Actors
  - → Private Sector in Kenya is strong, but cost of doing business is still high
  - → Enabling environment has to be improved to unleash Kenya`s growth potential (support to private sector in agriculture)
- 2. Reduce Inequalities and Social Exclusion
  - → Human Rights and fundamental freedoms (bill of rights) anchored in the constitution
  - → Increasing economic opportunities is the key for stability and peace (support national cohesion)
  - → German Development Cooperation will focus on Western Kenya with specific reference to urban poor and women





#### **Guiding Principles**

- 3. Respect, Protect and Fulfil Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms
  - → Implementing MDGs, progress in some MDGs, others are at stake
  - → Implementation of human rights agenda has to go along with a more effecient service delivery, strenghtening of the private sector and an effective regulation
- 4. <u>Support Political and Economic Governance, strengthening Accountability, Integrity, Transparency and the Rule of Law</u>
  - → Challenges in transforming the culture of impunity and corruption into a culture of accountability and rule of law
  - → Establish accountability systems at a local level in order to prevent the devolution of corruption
- 5. Improve Aid Effectivness to achieve Development Result
  - → Improving the modes of delivery





#### **Volume of Commitments**

For the period of 2010 - 2013, the Government of Germany has increased significantly the total contribution and provides to the Government of Kenya with a new amount of € 138 million for bilateral Technical and Financial Cooperation





#### Areas of Development Cooperation (1/2)

- Development strategy → Vision 2030
- Priority areas of bilateral cooperation :
  - → Development of the Water and Sanitation Sector
  - → Development of the Health Sector
  - → Private Sector Development in Agriculture





#### Areas of Development Cooperation (2/2)

- Additional support to:
  - → Good Governance with special emphasis on Access to Justice for Victims of Genderbased Violence
  - → Public Finance Reforms (incl. Transparent and Target-Orientated Budgeting and Capacity Development in Public Procurement)
  - → Education in Poor Urban and Peri-Urban Areas
  - → Renewable Energies and Energy Efficiency





#### Development of the Water and Sanitation Sector

- Achievements have been made in the implementation of the Water Sector Reforms:
  - Autonomy of institutions
  - Socially responsible commercialization
  - Devolution of asset management to sub-national level
- The future cooperation will focus on:
  - Reforms in the water sector,
  - Water supply and sanitation in secondary towns in Western Kenya
  - Water supply and sanitation urban informal settlements
  - Sustainable management of the water resources





#### **Development of Health Sector**

- Significant decline in under five and infant mortility rates
- The future cooperation will focus on:
  - Support of sector reforms
  - Support development, implementation and up-scaling of health financing models
  - Support sexual and reproductive health including HIV/AIDS
  - Fight against gender-based violence





#### Private Sector in Agriculture

- Agricultural Sector Development Strategy (ASDS)
- The future cooperation will focus on:
  - Structural reforms and improving the sectoral framework
  - Improving production and marketing conditions
  - Small scale irrigation
  - Reforming and improving delivery of agricultural services and research
  - → Strengthening of smallholders in areas with high and medium potential (Western Kenya)





#### **Education in Poor Urban and Peri-Urban Areas**

- Introduction of free primary education in 2003
- Germany agreed to extend the ongoing programme "Primary Education in Poor Urban Areas"
  - → Building and rehabilitation of primary and secondary schools in poor urban and peri-urban areas
  - → Support of innovative mechanisms to ensure equal education opportunities especially for girls





#### **Support to Good Governance**

- Germany will assist in the design of a governance, justice, law and order sector reform framework
  - → Support to the rule of law espeacially:
    - Implementation of the new constitution
    - Fight against corruption
    - Access to justice for the poor and survivers of gender-based violence
    - Human rights
  - → Support towards cooperation efforts between state and non-state actors





## Promotion of Social Justice, Reconciliation and National Cohesion

■ Started in 2009 as a direct reaction to overcome the structural causes of the post-election violence

Support to National Cohesion and Integration Commission





# Support to Public Finance Reforms (including Transparent and target-orientated budgeting and capacity development in public procurement)

- Additional reforms in the future:
  - → Intergovernmental fiscal relations and fiscal decentralisation
- The German support is focused to speed up the initiated budgeting and public procurment reforms,





#### Renewable Energies

 Since 2008, the German Government is financing renewable energy projects (esp. Concessional loans)

■ The German Financial Cooperation (KfW and DEG) will access opportunities for providing development and promotional loans for the further promotion of renewable energy and the enhancement of energy efficiency
