
## English group discussion "personal values"



  - common person of interest
  - lack of representation of citizenry needs
  - partnership of equals by Russia (narrative)
  - poor support by colonial masters in fighting rebels. Russia support in military equipment ie. nuclear weapon
  - excessive exploitation of resources and economy by the French West Africa.
- 2. Should Kenya stay strongly aligned to Western powers like UK, USA, EU or shift the alliance towards the BRICS states? Which advantages and disadvantages would this bring?
  - Kenya should remain neutral
  - The BRICS approach former global south nation
  - Advantages:
    - New stage of diplomacy and development financing
    - o Advancing Kenya interest globally
    - o Better markets for agricultural produce
- 3. Which advantages and disadvantages does the cooperation and alignment with China have for Kenya and for African states in general?
  - disadvantages:
    - o loss of traditional allies
    - collateral loan obligations / transparency
    - o introduction of yuan in African market
  - advantages:
    - o economic ties / investment
    - introduction of Mandarin into Africa
    - development cooperation
    - o new allies politically, socially and economically
